### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

#### Eligibility Criteria

For first-semester freshmen, the minimum high school GPA is 3.5, and the minimum SAT score is 1150 (Verbal and Math). If the student has taken the ACT, we look for a score of at least 24. Some exceptions apply.

Current college students who have a college GPA of at least 3.5 are eligible to apply.

Qualified Joint Enrollment/Accel students are welcome to apply to the program as well.

#### Program Completion

To complete the program, students must maintain an overall 3.2+ GPA and take at least four Honors courses (for an Associate's Degree) or eight Honors courses (for a Bachelor's Degree) before graduation. In addition, students in the Honors Program will participate in community service and Honors activities each semester. Students graduating from a Bachelor's program will also complete a Thesis or Capstone project as part of their 24 hours of Honors credit. Completion of Honors courses, along with active involvement in service and Honors activities, will be recognized on the student's transcripts by the designation "Honors Scholar" (Associate's) or "Honors Program Graduate" (Bachelor's).
