New Freshmen

Applicants, usually under the age of 23, who have not attended college after high school graduation.

Home School Students

Applicants from non-accredited home schools or non-accredited high schools.

Non-Traditional Students 

Applicants whose high school class graduated at least five years ago, hold a high school diploma or GED, and have earned fewer than 30 transferable semester hours of college credit.

Amendment 23: Fee Waiver for Persons 62 and Older 

Applicants 62 years of age or older who are Georgia residents AND wish to enroll in classes without payment of fees, except for supply, lab and shop fees. Applicants must also provide documents and meet requirements for their desired category above.

Auditing Students 

Applicants who submit evidence of graduation from an accredited or approved high school or GED certificate may register for courses as auditors. No academic or degree credit shall be awarded to auditing students. Students registered as auditors shall be required to pay the regular tuition and fees for enrollment. Students must inform the Registrar's Office and the professor, at the time of registration, that they wish to audit the course.
